MAN CHARGED WITH CHILD ABUSE OVER MARIJUANA COOKIES

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 40-year-old man accused of providing cookies laced with marijuana to two teenagers causing them to become ill.

Davirak Ky (dob: 09-12-73) is charged with two counts of *child abuse* (M), two counts of *second-degree assault* (F4) and two counts of *contributing to the delinquency of a minor* (F4).

The charges allege that on November 4, 2013, a 13-year-old boy and a 15-year-old boy unknowingly ate cookies laced with marijuana that Ky had baked and provided to them. The victims became ill and were transported to the hospital.

Ky has been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on November 20, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. to be advised of the charges.
