MAN CHARGED IN THREAT CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of making threats against four members of the paramedic command staff at Denver Health Medical Center last week.

Matthew Mann (dob: 09-24-74) is charged with four counts of stalking – threats (F5).

The charges allege that on April 11, 2013, Mann made repeated credible threats against the four command staff members who work in the EMS Division at DHMC.

Mann was arrested and has been released from custody on a \$50,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 26, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
