MAN CHARGED AFTER BOY FALLS FROM CAR

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man in an incident in which a toddler fell from a moving vehicle last Friday in the area of 40th Avenue and Lisbon Street.

Ross McCoy (dob: 03-15-80) is charged with *child abuse resulting in serious bodily injury* (F3), *child abuse without injury* (M), *leaving the scene of an accident* (F4), *aggravated driving after revocation* (F6) and *violation of a protection order* (M1).

The charges allege that McCoy was driving when a 2-year-old passenger removed himself from a seat belt, opened a rear passenger door, and fell from the moving vehicle as it was going around a corner. The charges further allege that he fled the scene without notifying police and was driving while his license was revoked.

McCoy remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Tuesday, July 2, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
