MAN FOUND GUILTY IN WOMAN'S MURDER

A 28-year-old man charged in the shooting death of 22-year-old Andrea Roan in December of 2011 has been found guilty by a Denver jury.

Ryan Miller (dob: 07-02-84) was convicted of *first-degree murder* (F1), *second-degree kidnapping* (F4), *first-degree burglary* (F3), *first-degree trespass* (F5) and *third-degree assault* (M). He faces life in prison without parole when he is sentenced June 10, 2013, in Denver District Court.

On December 16, 2011, Miller shot and killed Roan, a former girlfriend, as she was driving away from her home in the 1200 block of Clayton Street.

A co-defendant, **Richard Leavitt** (dob: 02-08-84), pleaded guilty earlier this year to second-degree murder for his role in driving Miller to and from the crime scene and helping him hide the murder weapon. He will be sentenced next month.
