WOMAN CHARGED IN FATAL PEDESTRIAN CRASH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of killing a pedestrian in May while driving drunk.

Candice Porch (dob: 06-18-86) is charged with *vehicular homicide* (F3), *DUI* (M) and *driving under restraint* (M).

The charges allege that on May 24, 2013, around 12:15 a.m., Porch struck and killed 57-year-old Rigoberto Landeros-Dorado as he tried to cross the street near the intersection of Havana and Exposition.

Porch has been released from custody on a \$50,000.00 bond. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 7, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
