### **MAN CHARGED IN NEW YEAR'S DAY SHOOTING**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 26-year-old man with murder and assault in connection with a shooting that occurred about 9:30 p.m. on New Year's Day.

**Robert Rubio** (dob: 01-23-86) is charged today with *second-degree murder* (F2) and *second-degree assault* (F4).

The charges allege that Rubio shot and killed 21-year-old Troy Martinez and wounded a 22-year-old man while the victims were visiting a friend at a home in the 1000 block of South Alcott Street on January 1, 2013.

Rubio remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center. His next court appearance has not yet been scheduled.
