MAN CHARGED IN ASSAULT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 20-year-old man accused of assaulting two men outside a hookah bar earlier in September. The charges were filed last Thursday.

Tilo Sandoval (06-22-93) is charged with second-degree assault (F4), third-degree assault (M1) and bias-motivated crime (F5).

The charges allege that on September 2, 2013, Sandoval assaulted two men, and that he did so because he thought they were gay.

Sandoval has been released from custody on \$30,000 bond. He appeared in Denver County Court today to be advised of the charges and is now scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on October 17, 2013, at 8:30 a.m. for a preliminary hearing.
