FOUR CHARGED IN LODO ASSAULT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a group of men accused of assaulting two victims and intimidating a witness last week.

Christopher Hobbs (dob: 05-18-84), **Keeland Willard** (dob: 06-03-89), and **Shawn Williams** (dob: 11-04-84) are all charged with multiple counts of *first-degree assault* (F3) and *crime of violence* (se).

Jerrol Jones (dob: 11-08-89) is also charged with *obstructing a peace officer* (M2) and *intimidation of a witness* (F4) in addition to the aforementioned charges.

The charges allege that on July 13, 2013, at around 2:00 a.m., a large fight broke out in the intersection at 15th and Market Streets. During the altercation, two men were injured and a third person was later the victim of an intimidation incident.

All four defendants are scheduled to appear in Denver County Court next week to be formally advised of the charges. Williams remains in custody. The other defendants have been released on bond.
