### **MAN CHARGED IN ELUDING CASE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of eluding a police officer and other charges following a chase that ended in a crash near 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Galapago Street earlier this week.

**Reginald Wray** (dob: 03-27-78) is charged with vehicular eluding (F5), three counts of possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6), possession of a controlled substance (M1), driving under the influence (M), obstructing a peace officer (M2), two counts of failure to remain at the scene of an accident (T2).

The charges allege that April 1, 2013, around 2 a.m., Wray failed to stop for a DUI traffic officer and a short time later crashed his car into two parked cars and then fled on foot. The charges further allege that he was in possession of illegal drugs and a loaded handgun.

Wray remains in custody; his bond has been set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Friday, April 5, 2013 at 9:30 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
