THREE CHARGED IN HASH OIL EXPLOSION

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three people accused of taking part in a marijuana hash oil extraction process that resulted in an explosion earlier this year.

Matthew Ackerman (dob: 02-22-90), **Danielle Cordova** (dob: 07-13-93) and **Paul Mannaioni** (dob: 04-17-90) are each charged with processing or manufacturing marijuana concentrate (F3).

The charges allege that the three were taking part in an illegal hash oil extraction process on April 23, 2014, in a warehouse at 1241 Lipan Street. They have all been released from custody on bond and are due in Denver County Court to be formally advised later in July.
