WOMAN CHARGED IN WEEKEND HIT/RUN CRASH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of causing a hit and run crash last Sunday afternoon near 14th Avenue and Quebec Street while driving drunk.

Nyeesha Gonzalez (dob: 03-22-77) is charged with two counts of *vehicular assault (F4)*, *leaving the scene of an accident resulting in injury (F4)*, *aggravated driving after revocation (F6)*, *resisting arrest (M2)* and *no proof of insurance (T1)*.

The charges allege that Gonzalez, who has had her driving privileges previously revoked, was driving drunk in the area of 14th Avenue and Quebec on November 16, 2014, and caused a crash that injured another person. The charges further allege that she fled the scene and resisted arrest after being located nearby a short time later.

She remains in custody; her bond is set at \$2,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on November 21, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
