MAN CHARGED IN BURGLARY IN WHICH SHOTS WERE FIRED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of breaking into a woman's home, stealing her car, and firing shots at her.

Marquise Jackson (dob: 07-18-96) is charged with *first-degree burglary* (F3), *attempted first-degree assault* (F4) and *aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F4).

The charges allege that on August 25, 2014, at about 2:30 a.m., Jackson broke into home in the 7000 block of East Exposition Avenue, stole a number of household items and fired shots at the victim as he fled in the victim's car. Jackson was arrested later that same day at a nearby apartment complex after someone reported a burglary in progress.

Jackson remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$25, 000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Tuesday, September 2, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
