CHARGES FILED IN WOMAN'S MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a Denver man accused of shooting and killing his wife Monday night.

Richard Kirk (dob: 05-15-66) is charged with one count of *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charge alleges that on April 14, 2014, Kirk shot and killed his wife, 44-year-old Kristine Ann Kirk, inside their home in the 2100 block of South St. Paul Street.

Kirk was taken into custody a short time later without incident and is being held without bond in the Denver Detention Center. He is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on Monday, April 21, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charge.
