MAN SENTENCED IN MARIJUANA COOKIE CASE

A 41-year-old man accused of providing marijuana-laced cookies last year to two teenagers who became ill has pleaded guilty and been sentenced.

Davirak Ky (dob: 09-12-73) pleaded guilty last week to distributing a controlled substance (DF4) and child abuse (M1) and has been sentenced to 3 years of probation. As part of his probation, he must undergo drug and alcohol treatment and take a class on the effects of drugs on children.

On November 4, 2013, a 13-year-old boy and a 15-year-old boy unknowingly ate cookies laced with marijuana that Ky had baked and provided to them. The victims became ill and were treated at a local hospital.
