TWO CHARGED IN ROBBERY AND CRASH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man and woman accused of robbing a Denver jewelry store at gunpoint earlier this week.

Stacy Mariney (dob: 07-09-14) and **Delawna Miller** (dob: 06-15-14) are charged with *kidnapping* (F2), eight counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3), four counts of *menacing* (F5), *vehicular eluding* (F5), and *theft* (F4).

The charges allege that on September 15, 2014, Mariney and Miller robbed a jewelry store at gunpoint, left with an undisclosed amount of merchandise and then crashed their car while trying to flee from police. Mariney and Miller were arrested Park Avenue West and Glenarm Place after the driver lost control and crashed.

Mariney and Miller are out of custody on a \$50,000 bond; they are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on October 2, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. to be advised of the charges.
