MAN CHARGED WITH INVASION OF PRIVACY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of taking pictures in a women's restroom.

Bradley Oglethorpe (dob: 06-27-1974) is charged with *invasion of privacy* (F6).

The charge alleges that Oglethorpe hid in the stall of a women's bathroom at a grocery store and took pictures of two children from under the stall using a cell phone. The incident occurred in January 2014. At the time, no suspect was identified. Oglethorpe was arrested as a suspect on June 13, 2014, after he was discovered in the same women's bathroom by a security officer.

Oglethorpe is currently being held in custody; his bond is set at \$2,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Thursday, June 19, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. for his second advisement on the charge.
