FOUR CHARGED IN VANDALISM AT STATE CAPITOL

Denver DA Mitch Morrissey has formally charged four men accused of spray painting graffiti on the Colorado State Capitol building last week.

Mason Martinez (dob: 08-07-96), **Sean Osborne** (dob: 07-01-80), **Cody Adamec** (dob: 10-19-93) and **Aaron Twinam** (dob: 02-25-89) are charged with *criminal mischief* (F6) and *defacing public property* (M2).

The charges allege that on November 5, 2014, at about 8:30 p.m., the four defendants were observed spray painting graffiti on the outside of the Colorado State Capitol building at 200 East Colfax Avenue.

Martinez and Osborne remain in custody; Twinam and Adamec have been released from custody on bond. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on November 21, 2014, at 8:30 a.m., to be formally advised of the charges.
