MAN CHARGED FOR KILLING GIRLFRIEND'S KITTEN

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of killing his girlfriend's kitten during a domestic violence incident last month.

Andres Sanchez-Luevano (07-19-91) is charged with one count of *aggravated cruelty to animals* (F6).

The charge alleges that on November 17, 2014, Sanchez-Luevano was arguing with his girlfriend when he picked up her 1-month-old kitten and threw it to the floor. The kitten did not survive.

Sanchez-Luevano has been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond. He will appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 today at 9:30 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
