MAN CHARGED IN ELUDING CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of eluding police on May 16, 2014.

Jeffrey Strouse (dob: 03-30-63) is charged with *vehicular eluding* (F5) and *aggravated driving after revocation* (F6).

The charges allege that Strouse fled a traffic stop in Aurora around 11 p.m. on May 16, 2014, and was eventually stopped and taken into custody at 56th and Tucson in Denver, after ramming a police vehicle.

Strouse remains in custody; his bond is set at \$100,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Wednesday, May 28, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
