WOMAN CHARGED IN HIT AND RUN

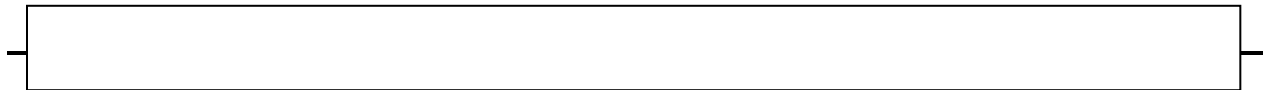
District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman in connection with a hit and run crash involving a pedestrian that occurred in Denver on August 16, 2014.

Amanda Suhr (dob 2-28-1994) is charged with *leaving the scene of an accident involving serious bodily injury (F4), failure to report accident (T2), no operator's license (T2) and no proof of insurance (T1)*.

The charges allege that on August 16, 2014, at about 2:30 p.m., Suhr was driving northbound on Federal Boulevard when she struck a pedestrian who was crossing the roadway at 14th Avenue. The charges further allege that Suhr stopped briefly but then fled the scene. Witnesses to the crash were able to provide police with information and photos that led to her arrest the following day.

Suhr remains in custody; bond is set at \$50,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Friday, August 22, 2014, to be advised of the charges.
