SCHOOL SECURITY GUARD CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 22-year-old school security guard who is accused of sending sexual text messages to students, and attempting to lure at least one student into a sexual relationship.

Enrique Vega (dob: 06-30-92) is charged with two counts of *sexual exploitation of a child* (F3) and one count of *attempted sexual assault on a child* (F5).

The charges allege that in August and September, Vega was exchanging and had in his possession sexually exploitative material and engaged in conduct that was a substantial step toward committing sexual assault on a child. The charges are the result of an investigation that began when school leaders learned of the allegations and immediately contacted Denver police.

Vega was arrested on September 8, 2014, and has been released from custody on a \$25,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 tomorrow, September 23, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
