MAN CHARGED IN POLICE SHOOTING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting at police officers while in police custody last week.

Isaac Vigil (dob: 04-09-82) is charged with two counts of attempted first-degree murder (F2), two counts of first-degree assault (F3), possession of a controlled substance (F4), possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6), and possession of a defaced firearm (M).

The charges allege that on May 14, 2014, Vigil was in custody at the Denver District 4 police station when he fired a gun at police officers. Vigil remains in custody; his bond is set at \$1,000,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on May 22, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
