MAN CHARGED WITH MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 29-year-old man with murder following a fatal shooting in the 3200 block of W. Avondale Drive on March 26, 2014.

Timothy Wakefield (07-02-84) is charged with *first-degree murder after deliberation* (F1).

The charge alleges that Wakefield and the victim, 30-year-old Christopher R. Demarco of Pennsylvania, had been arguing and that Wakefield shot the victim as he was leaving Wakefield's home.

Wakefield was taken into custody at the scene by an apartment security guard and remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center. He is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on April 4, 2014, at 8:30 a.m., to be formally advised of the charge.
