MAN CHARGED IN ROBBERY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of robbing a bank and then using light rail to try to make his get-away.

Michael Whittington (dob: 09-19-69) is charged with one count of robbery (F4).

The charge alleges that on September 23, 2014, at about 5 p.m., Whittington robbed a bank on the 16th Street Mall, between Welton and California Streets, and then boarded a light rail train. Police stopped the train a few blocks away and took Whittington into custody without incident.

He remains in custody; his bond is set at \$5,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Tuesday, September 30, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. to be advised of the charge.
