THREE CHARGED IN MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men in connection with the murder earlier this month of 61-year-old Samuel Grady in his northwest Denver home.

Chad Baluska (dob: 11-25-76), **Eric Fuhs** (dob: 05-07-90), and **Derek Webb** (11-18-86) are each charged with *first-degree murder, after deliberation* (F1), two counts of *felony murder* (F1), *burglary* (F3) and *aggravated robbery* (F3).

The charges allege that on May 6, 2015, the three defendants went to the victim's home in the 4900 block of Green Court, shot him, then stole his wallet and his truck. Baluska was arrested in the stolen truck the next day. Fuhs, who is Grady's nephew, was arrested on May 9, 2015. Webb was arrested on May 11, 2015.

All three remain in custody without bond in the Denver Detention Center. They are scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on Wednesday, May 20, 2015, at 10 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
