### **GUILTY PLEA IN VEHICULAR ASSAULT**

A man accused of driving into three Denver police officers on bicycles last December, seriously injuring one of the officers, has pleaded guilty in connection with the case.

**Christopher Booker** (dob: 03-09-73) pleaded guilty to *vehicular assault* (F5) and *attempt to influence a public servant* (F4).

On December 3, 2014, Booker was driving a vehicle that crashed into three Denver police officers who were on bicycles at Colfax Avenue and High Street. Officer John Adsit was seriously injured after being caught underneath the vehicle and dragged. The charges further allege that Booker knew he should not be driving, because of a medical condition, and that he gave untruthful information to the Colorado Department of Motor Vehicles so that he could obtain a driver's license.

Booker faces a sentence ranging from probation up to 9 years in prison when he is sentenced on December 4, 2015, at 1:30 p.m.
