MAN CHARGED IN POLICE SHOOTING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused in a shooting incident that occurred on South Havana Street last Saturday

Omari Cook-Nunn (dob: 12-23-94) has been charged with first-degree assault (F3), felony menacing (F5) and possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6).

Cook-Nunn is accused of firing shots toward an Aurora police officer who was responding to reports of gunfire at an apartment complex at about 2:30 a.m. on January 3, 2015. Cook-Nunn was then shot by the officer; he has been treated and released for the wound and remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center. His bond is set at \$100,000.

Cook-Nunn is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 tomorrow, Friday, January 9, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. to be advised of the charges.

The police-shooting aspect of the investigation is still on-going by the Denver Police Department and has not yet been reviewed by the District Attorney.
