MAN CHARGED IN ROBBERY OF ELDERLY WOMAN

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man in connection with the tax-refund robbery of an elderly woman last week.

Jesse Giron (11-05-75) is charged with *robbery of an at-risk victim* (F3).

The charge alleges that on March 30, 2015, at about 2:30 p.m., Giron and another man were at a Wal-Mart store at 7800 East Smith Road when a 70-year-old woman was robbed of her tax-refund money. Giron is accused of driving the get-away vehicle.

Giron has been released from custody on a \$10,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 16, 2015, at 1:30 p.m., to be formally advised of the charge.

The other suspect in the case, **Lenny Esquibel** (dob: 08-05-75) is wanted and is still at-large. Anyone with information about his whereabouts should contact local law enforcement.
