TWO CHARGED IN VANDALISM

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two people accused of vandalizing the Fallen Officer Memorial in the plaza at Denver Police Headquarters.

Robert Guerrero (dob: 01-19-90) and **Matthew Goldberg** (dob: 04-21-91) are each charged with *criminal mischief* (F4), *defacing public property* (M2), *desecration of a venerated object* (M3), and *resisting arrest* (M2).

The charges allege that on February 14, 2015, Guerrero and Goldberg defaced the Fallen Officer Memorial and then resisted arrest when contacted by police.

Both defendants have been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond and are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Monday, March 2, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
