MAN PLEADS GUILTY IN 1981 COLD CASE

Yesterday, defendant **Hector Bencomo-Hinojos** (dob: 10-15-1959) plead guilty in a 1981 sexual homicide case. The case, filed in 2013, was marked by being the 100th case filed in the Cold Case Project.

Bencomo-Hinojos was originally charged with *first-degree murder after deliberation* (F1) and *first-degree murder*, *felony murder-sexual assault* (F1) in the death of 32-year old Patricia Beard.

Yesterday's plea dismissed the first degree murder counts and had a plea to one count of Second Degree Murder (F2) and one count of First Degree Kidnapping (F2). Each substantive count had a crime of violence count attached to it. The parties agreed to a stipulated sentence of 48 years (24 years per count) in DOC plus one year of mandatory parole per count (as was required by law in 1981).

Bencomo-Hinojos will be sentenced on June 8 at 1:30.
