### **WOMAN CHARGED IN EMBEZZLEMENT CASE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a bookkeeper accused of stealing tens of thousands of dollars from the employer she had worked for over the last several years.

Kristie Marx (dob: 07-27-70) is charged with computer crime (F3), two counts of theft (F3, F4) and two counts of forgery (F5).

The charges allege that Marx, through different schemes, stole more than \$150,000 from Blue Moon Works, a computer graphics company. The schemes are alleged to have included charging personal items to a company credit card, giving herself an unauthorized pay raise, manipulating her state and federal withholding tax, writing herself checks from the company account, and adding herself and her dependents to the company health insurance plan.

Marx was arrested last week and was formally advised of the charges yesterday. She remains out of custody on a \$10,000 bond. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 13, 2015, at 8:30 a.m., for a preliminary hearing.
