UBER DRIVER CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED BURGLARY

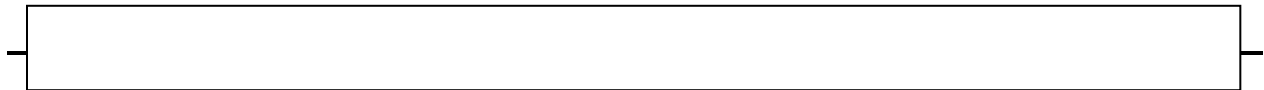
Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of trying to break into the home of an Uber passenger he had dropped off at the airport.

Gerald Montgomery (12/16/1963) has been charged with attempted second-degree burglary (F4), possession of burglary tools (F5), and attempted first-degree criminal trespass (F6).

The charges allege that on March 26, 2015, Montgomery, an Uber driver, tried to break into the home of a passenger he had taken to the airport earlier that morning. A roommate who was home at the time was able to call police. Montgomery was later identified as a suspect and was arrested a few days later.

Montgomery has been released from custody on a \$10,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 14, 2015, at 8:30 a.m., for his second advisement.
