MAN SENTENCED IN INVASION OF PRIVACY CASE

A man accused of taking pictures in a women's restroom last summer has been sentenced to jail time.

Bradley Oglethorpe (dob: 06-27-1974) pleaded guilty earlier to two counts of *invasion of privacy* (M1). He was sentenced today to two years in jail for each count, to be served consecutive for a total of four years.

Oglethorpe hid in the stall of a women's bathroom at a grocery store and took pictures of two children from under the stall using a cell phone. Although the first incident occurred in January 2014, Oglethorpe wasn't arrested as a suspect until June 2014, after he was discovered in the same women's bathroom by a security officer.

Oglethorpe will serve the jail time in the Colorado Department of Corrections where he is currently serving a prison term on another matter.
