MAN CHARGED WITH MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man in connection with a shooting last week on Albrook Drive that left one man dead and a woman injured.

Jesse L. Oliver (dob: 11-06-82) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1) and *first-degree assault* (F3).

The charges allege that on September 16, 2015, at about 11:15 p.m., Oliver shot and killed 34-year-old Bobby Brown and injured a 17-year-old female outside of an apartment building in the 13000 block of Albrook Drive in Denver.

Oliver was arrested at the scene and remains in custody in the Denver Detention, where he is being held without bond. His first court appearance has not yet been set.
