WOMAN CHARGED IN TEEN FIGHT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman who is accused taking part in a fight between her daughter and a fellow student.

Selina Ramirez (05-07-77) is charged with *third-degree assault* (M1), and two counts of *contributing to the delinquency of a minor* (F4)

The charges allege that on April 22, 2015, Ramirez participated in a fight between her 16-year-old daughter and another teenager across the street from their school, not only encouraging the fight but also shoving the other girl to the ground.

Ramirez has been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 11, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
