MAN CHARGED IN AIRPORT INCIDENT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of going out onto the ramp area at Denver International Airport to try and stop a departing plane.

Marc Rehmar (dob: 06-14-57) is charged with *endangering public transportation* (F3) and *hindering transportation* (M2).

The charges allege that on August 6, 2015, at about 10:30 a.m., Rehmar pushed open a secure emergency exit on the concourse and ran out onto the ramp area to try and stop a plane that was being pushed back from the gate. The door triggered an alarm and airport employees and Denver police responded immediately.

Rehmar has been released from custody on a \$10,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 21, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
