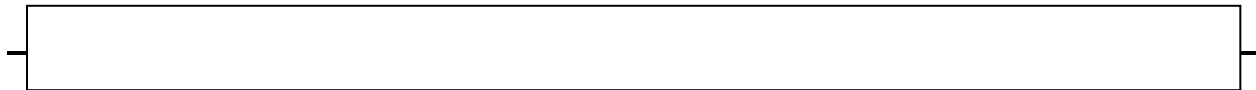
WOMAN SENTENCED IN SHOOTING OF TEEN

A woman accused of shooting a 14-year-old girl in the arm last summer has been sentenced today in connection with the case.

Cherry Robertson (dob: 08-15-80) pleaded guilty earlier to menacing (F5), third-degree assault (M1) and carrying a concealed weapon (M2) in the August 2, 2014, shooting in the 1100 block of Rosemary Street. She was sentenced to a three-year deferred judgment sentence, including an additional 60 days in jail, two years of probation, and 75 hours of community service work.

On August 2, 2014, following an altercation between Robertson's daughter and the 14-year-old victim, Robertson fired a shot from a handgun, striking the victim in the arm. The victim was taken to the hospital and was treated and released.
