FORMER CITY WORKER PLEADS GUILTY

A former Denver city employee accused of accepting money in exchange for his influence as a public servant has pleaded guilty in connection with the case.

Larry Stevenson (dob: 05-29-69) pleaded guilty this morning to two counts of *failure to disclose a conflict of interest* (M2). He went to immediate sentencing and was given one year probation (unsupervised), ordered to pay \$5,500 in restitution, and must surrender his concealed-carry permit as a condition of his bond.

Stevenson was an employee of Denver's Excise and Licensing Department when he was accused of accepting \$5,000 to help a local businessman secure contracts without going through a formal bidding process. He was not successful in his efforts to influence the contract process.

This case was worked jointly by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Denver District Attorney's Office.
