MAN CHARGED WITH ROBBERY - AGAIN

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man in connection with a Denver bank robbery that occurred in September 2014.

Steven C. Talley (dob: 12-23-70) is charged with one count of *aggravated robbery* (F3).

Talley was originally charged in two bank robbery cases in 2014 but the cases were dismissed after he provided an alibi for one of them. The Rocky Mountain Safe Streets Task Force continued the investigation into the second robbery, and their work resulted in Talley's arrest last week. The charge filed yesterday alleges that Talley robbed a US Bank on South Colorado Boulevard on September 5, 2014 and fled with an undisclosed amount of cash.

Talley remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 tomorrow, December 16, 2015, to be formally advised of the charge.
