WOMAN CHARGED WITH ASSAULT ON OFFICERS

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of assaulting two police officers following a disturbance outside a bar last weekend.

Brittany Thomas (dob: 07-16-87) is charged with two counts of *second-degree assault on a peace officer* (F4) and one count of *resisting arrest* (M2).

Thomas was with a group of people loitering in the 1400 block of N. Uinta Street on June 26, 2015, and tried to flee when responding officers found she had a warrant out for her arrest. The charges allege that Thomas scratched and kicked two officers as she resisted arrest.

Thomas remains in custody; bond is set at \$5,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Monday, July 6, 2015, at 8:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
