CHARGES FILED IN SEPARATE FATAL CRASHES

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two people accused in separate fatal drunk driving crashes that occurred last weekend.

April Wilson (05-05-79) has been charged with one count of vehicular homicide (F3) and two counts driving under the influence (M). The charges allege that Wilson was driving drunk when she hit another vehicle on Sunday, April 12, 2015. The collision resulted in the death of 27-year-old Nathan Real.

Wilson appeared in Denver County Court this morning to be formally advised of the charges; she is scheduled to appear again on May 7, 2015 at 8:30 a.m. for a preliminary hearing.

In a separate case, **Ryan Winicki** (03-21-75) has been charged with one count of vehicular homicide (F3) and two counts driving under the influence (M). The charges allege that on Sunday, April 12, 2015, Ryan was driving drunk when he struck a pedestrian with his vehicle at Colfax Avenue and Logan Street, killing Alfonzo Pullen. Winicki appeared to initially flee the scene but returned and was taken into custody.

Winicki is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 27, 2015, at 9:30 a.m., to be formally advised of the charges.
