WOMAN CHARGED IN AT-RISK THEFT AND FORGERY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman in connection with forging several checks from three assisted living residents she worked with.

Bridget Thomas (dob: 3-9-75) is charged with *theft of an at-risk elder* (F3) and *forgery* (F5).

The charges allege that during her employment at a retirement home, Thomas was able to obtain and cash checks from residents resulting in several thousand dollars in losses.

Thomas has been released from custody on a \$10,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on May 4, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. for her second advisement.
