MOM SENTENCED IN FIRE THAT HURT KIDS

A woman who left her two young children at home and unattended when the home caught fire last fall, has been sentenced in connection with the case.

Rocio Arroyo-Reyes (dob: 07-19-85) pleaded guilty earlier to two counts of *child abuse resulting in serious bodily injury* (F4). She has been sentenced to 10 days in jail and 4 years of probation.

In the morning hours of September 29, 2015, Arroyo-Reyes left two children, ages 3 and 5, unsupervised in their home in the 300 block of South Eliot Street. Firefighters responded to a report of a structure fire at the home and rescued the children, who were taken to the hospital for treatment.
