MAN CHARGED IN BALCONY SHOOTING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of aiming a gun, later determined to be a BB gun, at passersby last weekend.

James Bronish (dob: 05-19-59) is charged with five counts of felony menacing (F5).

The charges allege that on Sunday, June 12, 2016, Bronish was on a balcony at 1955 Arapahoe Street, pointing what appeared to be a gun at people passing by. Bronish was shot and injured after also pointing the weapon at officers who had responded. He was taken into custody and the gun was found to be a short shotgun-style BB gun.

Bronish remains in custody; his bond is set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on June 20, 2016.
