MAN CHARGED IN DOUBLE HOMICIDE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of killing a 25-year-old woman and her 45-year-old mother, whose bodies were found in their home in the 5500 block of Revere Street last week.

Angel Chavez (dob: 05-23-89) has been charged with two counts of *first-degree murder* (F1) and *violation of a protection order* (M1).

The charges allege that on the morning of July 22, 2016, Chavez fatally stabbed the mother of his two children, Maira Cordero, and her mother, Raquel Cordero. He then fled the scene but was arrested later that day. Chavez is currently on parole for a 2007 child abuse conviction, and had a warrant out for his arrest for violating a protection order.

Chavez remains in custody and is being held without bond. His next Denver court date has not yet been set.
