MOTORCYCLISTS FORMALLY CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men accused of reckless driving in July on I-25 through Denver.

Ryan Easton, Clinton Hawkins and Richard Patton are charged with reckless driving (T1) and speed exhibition (T1).

The charges allege that on July 24, 2016, at about 3:30 p.m., they were each riding a motorcycle on I-25 near Steele Street in a reckless manner, speeding and engaging in unlawful stunts on the highway.

Easton, Hawkins and Patton are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 4C this afternoon at 1:30 for their first appearance, which is an arraignment on these charges.
