### **CHARGES FILED IN TRIPLE HOMICIDE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three people in connection with a triple homicide that occurred earlier in June in Park Hill. The charges were filed on June 9, 2016.

**Chadd Evans** (03-22-84), **Dejuan Jones** (05-11-93) and **Deashaun Turrentine** (01-18-92) are each charged with two counts of first-degree murder (F1), five counts of attempted first-degree murder (F2), and one count of aggravated robbery (F3).

The charges allege that Evans, Jones, and Turrentine came to Denver from Oklahoma to illegally purchase several pounds of marijuana, and that during the transaction on June 3, 2016, they shot and killed two men and tried to kill five others. The incident took place in the 3600 block of Hudson Street and also resulted in the death of Derrius Woods, an associate of the defendants.

Evans has been taken into custody in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Turrentine has been taken into custody in Las Vegas, Nevada. Jones remains at-large. Denver court dates have not yet been set.
