MAN SENTENCED IN '98 AND '00 COLD CASE SEXUAL ASSAULTS

A man convicted earlier this year in two separate cold case sexual assaults has been sentenced today to nearly 100 years in prison.

Warren Foster (dob: 11-05-68), convicted earlier of first-degree sexual assault, second-degree kidnapping, sexual assault with force, two counts of third-degree assault, and false imprisonment, was sentenced to a 98½ year indeterminate-to-life term in the Colorado Department of Corrections.

Foster sexually assaulted an 18-year-old in 1998; the young woman had just arrived in Denver and was trying to find her friend's home when Foster offered her a ride. Foster also sexually assaulted a 27-year-old woman in 2000, again offering to give her a ride. The cases were linked by a case-to-case DNA match in 2011, and although Foster was charged at that time, he was serving a prison sentence in New Mexico for sexual assault and was not brought back to Denver until 2014.

The conviction and lengthy sentence is the result of dedicated work by Denver's Cold Case Project, particularly Denver Police Detective Larry Moore, and prosecutors Dawn Weber and Adrienne Greene.
