FORMER COUNCIL CANDIDATE PLEADS GUILTY

A former candidate for Denver City Council who was accused of forging petition signatures has pleaded guilty in connection with the case.

Corrie Houck (dob: 01-09-71) pleaded guilty yesterday to one count of *attempt to influence a public servant* (F4). Other counts of forgery and perjury were dismissed in exchange for the guilty plea. She was sentenced to a 2-year deferred judgment sentence with supervised probation, and was ordered to complete 50 hours of community service.

Houck signed and submitted ballot petitions last spring that contained forged petition signatures.
