OFFICER CITED FOR PROHIBITED USE OF WEAPON

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a Denver police officer accused of aiming his service weapon at two other officers while on duty at Denver police headquarters.

Anselmo (Sal) Jaramillo (dob: 01-17-70) is charged by summons with two counts of *prohibited use of weapons* (M2).

The charges allege that on September 18, 2016, Jaramillo was on-duty at 1331 Cherokee Street when he placed his loaded handgun on a desk and maneuvered it so that it was aimed at two other officers.

He was cited by summons and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court on November 9, 2016.
